3. Product description and intended use

A modular wall-mounted training system comprising one or two compact mini ladder modules and an optional removable training base. Depending on its installed position, the removable element can be used for pull-ups or as dip handles. Main components are made from solid beech wood and birch plywood.

- Controlled hanging, mobility and stretching exercises on the ladder modules
- Pull-ups and related exercises with the compatible base
- Dips and supported bodyweight exercises in the approved configuration

4. Declaration

The manufacturer declares under its sole responsibility that the product identified above has been designed and manufactured so that, when correctly installed where applicable and used for its intended purpose in accordance with the supplied instructions and warnings, it complies with the general safety requirement and applicable manufacturer obligations of Regulation (EU) 2023/988.

5. Basis of the declaration

- Product specification, materials and construction review
- Internal assessment of intended use and reasonably foreseeable misuse
- Assessment of mechanical, stability, entrapment, fall and installation hazards as applicable
- Manufacturer functional inspection and quality-control procedures
- User instructions, mounting requirements and safety warnings

6. Essential safety conditions

- Install every wall module only to a suitable load-bearing wall using the specified attachment points and appropriate fasteners.
- Observe the required spacing and alignment between two modules. Misaligned modules may prevent correct accessory seating.
- Before each exercise, confirm that the removable base is fully seated and cannot lift or slide out.
- Do not use the pull-up or dip accessory on incompatible ladders or improvised supports.
- Avoid shock loading, swinging and uncontrolled transitions between exercises.
- Children require direct adult supervision. Inspect all wood, plywood, joints and wall fasteners regularly.

7. Regulatory status

This is a voluntary manufacturer product-safety and compliance declaration. It is not an EU Declaration of Conformity issued under CE-marking legislation. Based on the product function described above, no CE mark is affixed under this declaration. Any third-party wall, door frame, gym ladder, hangboard, climbing hold, fastener or accessory remains subject to its own suitability, limits and documentation.

8. Technical documentation and validity

The manufacturer retains product identification, construction information, internal risk assessment, test or inspection records, user-safety information and traceability records for the period required by Regulation (EU) 2023/988. This declaration applies only to an unmodified product. Unauthorised modification, incorrect installation, misuse or use with incompatible components may invalidate this declaration.
