3. Product description and intended use

A multifunctional pair of wooden training bars designed for use as freestanding parallettes in two orientations and as a wall-mounted pull-up bar when correctly installed on compatible WhiteOak Modular wall rails. In wall configuration, the grips are positioned approximately 32 cm from the wall.

- Push-ups, L-sits, handstand and controlled calisthenics exercises as parallettes
- Pull-ups, chin-ups and controlled hanging exercises on compatible WhiteOak Modular rails

4. Declaration

The manufacturer declares under its sole responsibility that the product identified above has been designed and manufactured so that, when correctly installed where applicable and used for its intended purpose in accordance with the supplied instructions and warnings, it complies with the general safety requirement and applicable manufacturer obligations of Regulation (EU) 2023/988.

5. Basis of the declaration

- Product specification, materials and construction review
- Internal assessment of intended use and reasonably foreseeable misuse
- Assessment of mechanical, stability, entrapment, fall and installation hazards as applicable
- Manufacturer functional inspection and quality-control procedures
- User instructions, mounting requirements and safety warnings

6. Essential safety conditions

- For floor use, place both bars symmetrically on a level, dry, clean and non-slip surface.
- For wall use, install the WhiteOak Modular rails only to a suitable load-bearing wall and verify that both bars are fully engaged and locked.
- Never use the bars on incompatible rails or improvised mounting points.
- Do not change configuration while the product is loaded.
- Avoid swinging, kipping, shock loading and lateral twisting in wall-mounted use.
- Inspect bars, joints, rail engagement and wall fasteners before each use. Inverted exercises should be performed only by competent users with suitable precautions.

7. Regulatory status

This is a voluntary manufacturer product-safety and compliance declaration. It is not an EU Declaration of Conformity issued under CE-marking legislation. Based on the product function described above, no CE mark is affixed under this declaration. Any third-party wall, door frame, gym ladder, hangboard, climbing hold, fastener or accessory remains subject to its own suitability, limits and documentation.

8. Technical documentation and validity

The manufacturer retains product identification, construction information, internal risk assessment, test or inspection records, user-safety information and traceability records for the period required by Regulation (EU) 2023/988. This declaration applies only to an unmodified product. Unauthorised modification, incorrect installation, misuse or use with incompatible components may invalidate this declaration.
